## Equipment Required:

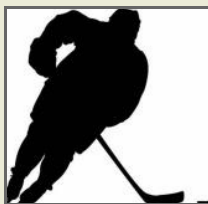

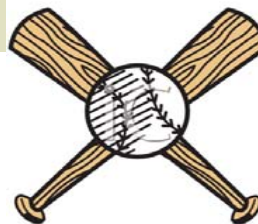
