

THE CORPORATION OF TAY VALLEY TOWNSHIP

BY-LAW NO. 10-070

A By-law to appoint Fence Viewers for Tay Valley Township and to adopt associated provisions associated with line fences.


WHEREAS Section 2 of the Line Fences Act, R.S.O. 1990 Chapter L/17, requires the Council of a local municipality to appoint by by-law fence viewers; and

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of Tay Valley Township enacts as follows:


1. That Councillor Bill Avery, Howard Farrell and Jay Playfair be appointed as fence viewers for the Corporation of Tay Valley Township.
2. That Alan Munro be appointed as an alternate to act as a fence viewer in the event that one of the other three appointees is not available.
3. That the said valuers shall be guided in the performance of their duties by the provisions of the Line Fences Act.
4. That no arbitration or other proceeding requiring the attendance or reattendance of fence viewers shall be scheduled between the 1st day of November and the 31st day of March in the next following year.
5. That the said valuers shall be entitled to be paid per visit/meeting at the rate set out for the Committee of Adjustment and Police Services Board, as well as mileage at the set rate determined by the Township, while performing duties of the valuer.
6. That all costs incurred by the Clerk in processing a Request for Fence Viewers, including the Clerk's time at the then current salary rate, be logged as an acceptable administrative cost and billed to the parties as directed by the Fence Viewers in their final determination of the application.
7. That By-law 07-032 and all previous by-laws pertaining to Fence Viewers are hereby rescinded.

8. That this by-law and the appointment fixed herein shall be deemed to take effect immediately upon passage.
