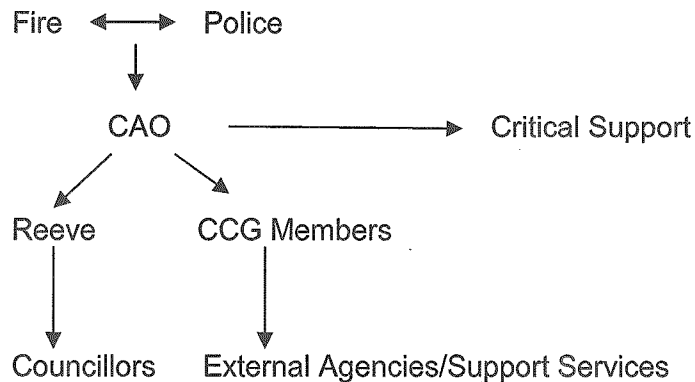


Emergency Alert Fanout System

It is most likely that Police and/or Fire services will be aware of a situation which has or has the potential of escalating. Notwithstanding any member of the CCG may initiate stand-by procedures through notice to the CAO



There are two types of instructions that will have to be issued in the event of an emergency that requires activation of the Tay Valley Plan, and they are:

- Being placed on stand-by, and
- Activation of the Plan

Being Placed on Stand-by

The purpose of the alerting instruction is to advise all participants in the Tay Valley Plan of the situation to enable them to prepare for involvement should they be required. It will normally be issued by the CAO/Emergency Coordinator immediately after receipt of the initial situation report. This is not an executive order to move.

Activation of the Plan

The purpose of the operations instruction is to clarify the scope of the emergency, the necessary response, which elements are to be involved, and how the operations are to be carried out. It will normally be issued by the CAO/Emergency Coordinator after the Community Control Group has determined the action required.
