

THE CORPORATION OF TAY VALLEY TOWNSHIP

BY-LAW NO. 08-020

A By-law to designate Community Safety Zones on parts of the Tay Valley Township owned roadways where public safety is of special concern.


WHEREAS s. 214.1(1) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8 authorizes municipalities to pass a by-law to designate a part of a highway under its jurisdiction as a Community Safety Zone; and


WHEREAS s. 214.1(1) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. H.8 requires that a by-law designating a Community Safety Zone shall specify the hours, days and months when the designation is in effect;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of Tay Valley Township enacts as follows:

1. That certain areas and parts of roadways where public safety is of concern as outlined in Schedule "A" and attached hereto are designated Community Safety Zones.
2. That the Reeve and Clerk of the Corporation are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the said actions of the Council.
3. That the Reeve and Clerk are authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary in that behalf, and the Clerk is authorized and directed to affix the Seal of the Corporation on all such documents.
4. That designated Community Safety Zones 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule "A", as established by previous by-laws continue un-interrupted from the date of passing of this by-law.
5. That designated Community Safety Zone 4 of Schedule "A" shall come into force and take effect on May 1st, 2008 and upon erection of signage in accordance with the Highway Traffic Act and regulations.
6. By-law No. 99-32 and 00-61 are hereby rescinded.

Schedule "A" to By-law No. 08-021

The following are the areas or parts of roadways designated as Community Safety Zones:

1. Harper Road from the intersection of Highway No. 7 for a distance of 500 metres North to a sign.
2. Glen Tay Road from the intersection of Highway No. 7 for a distance of 397 metres South to the intersection of County Road 6.
3. Christie Lake North Shore Road from the intersection of County Road 6 for a distance of 2,440 metres to the Westerly limit of the property identified as Roll No. 0911-916-010-14201 to a sign.
4. Glen Tay Road from the intersection of Christie Lake Road (County Road 6) for a distance of 200 metres east of Miller Lane to a sign.
